Virginia Governor Bob McDonnell recently proclaimed September 29 as a Day to Serve, urging all Virginia residents to reach out in their neighborhood in way to help one another. The members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, Bristow, decided to focus their service in providing Thanksgiving food baskets for the clients of the Haymarket Regional Food Pantry. All during the day, bags and boxes of

non-perishable food items made their way into the church gymnasium. Volunteers quickly emptied the bags, sorting the items into the categories designated for the basket and then hurried out to bring in the next load. At times whole cartons of donated canned goods were wheeled in by smiling members of the church. The group originally planned to assemble 250 baskets from 10:00AM to noon, but the work crew toiled until after 6 PM assembling 396 baskets. Making it Easier for You to Support the Food Pantry

In an effort to make it easier for you to support the Haymarket Regional Food Pantry in providing food to those in need, we have been hard at work implementing some simple and low cost solutions. Simply visit our website at <u>http://www.haymarketfoodpantry.org</u> to learn about these new features:

- **Donate Now** Click on the Donate button on the top right side of the website to make a secure online donation. You can use this option to donate a one-time gift or set up automatic recurring payments. The Haymarket Regional Food Pantry is a Charitable 501(C)(3) Organization.
- **Submit a Volunteer Application** no more printing, writing and mailing a paper volunteer application! Now you can visit our volunteer page to complete the entire volunteer application online. Once submitted, your application will be routed to the volunteer coordinator who will contact you to schedule a training session.

- Sign Up for Shift Work gone are the days of multiple emails coordinating coverage of volunteer shifts. With our new online calendar, our volunteer coordinator now invites our volunteers to view the open schedule online where they can sign-up for any open shifts at the food pantry, or other pantry events.
- Buy Tickets Our next fundraising event is Mardi Gras Casino Night, and will be held on February 9, 2013. You are now able to purchase and print tickets directly on the food pantry's website. 38% of our ticket sales for our Fall Fundraiser were purchased online, and we are looking forward to more online ticket sales for future events!
- Find Donation Locations Can't make it to the food pantry to drop off donated items? We have started a list on our website of Donation Locations, or local businesses that will collect and deliver donated items to the food pantry. Did You Know? Hunger Facts and Statistics

- 1. Based on the 2011 findings of the U.S. Census Bureau, more than 12% of the population in the state of Virginia is food insecure. It is a myth to think that people who need food are chronically poor. More likely, the person is unemployed, underemployed, suffering from poor health, or enduring the loss of a spouse.
- 2. In the first six months of 2012, the Haymarket Regional Food Pantry distributed food to approximately 6,500 individuals. Over the summer, we have seen an increase to over 350 individuals per week.
