For Thanksgiving, members of the Bristow Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints spearheaded a mammoth food collection.

Joining their manpower with that of other pantry volunteers, 346 baskets were prepared and distributed. Aiding in the effort was a generous donation of 100 turkeys by ADAMS of Greater Gainesville.

Christmas saw an increased demand with 408 requests for Christmas baskets.



From Our Maintenance Team




Did You Know?

• In 2012, the HRFP provided food to 399 registered clients throughout the year (up from 92 in 2010, and 240 in 2011). Every week, each registered

client receives food for their household (ranging in size from 1 to 11 people). (See the chart on the right.)
