Our History

Beginning as a small food closet at St. Paul's Anglican Church in 2005, the food pantry grew with additional support of St. Katharine Drexel Catholic Mission and the Town of Haymarket. Our board now also includes Park Valley Church and Gainesville United Methodist Church.

Our Mission

The Haymarket Regional Food Pantry is dedicated to eliminating hunger by providing food to those in need of assistance in Haymarket and the surrounding area. With your help, we can continue to **Help Other People Eat**.

Who We Help

The Haymarket Regional Food Pantry will feed anyone within its service area in need of food. Clients are seen by appointment and may come as often as once a week. We serve 250- 275 clients each week, feeding over 1,250 people: 38% are children (0-18) and 8% are seniors (65+). If you, or someone you know, are in need of food assistance, the Food Pantry can help.

Facts About the Food Pantry

- In 2021, we helped over 2,950 people each month: That's over 35 thousand people for the year.
- Each week, we distribute 900+ boxes of macaroni, spaghetti, and cereal; 1,200+ cans of fruit & vegetables.
- Our partnerships with local grocers and farms help us regularly provide clients with fresh produce and meat.
- Last year, we received (and gave out) over 327 thousand lbs of food. Even so, our shelves are often bare.
- To supplement food donations, we purchase food from the Capital Area Food Bank and local grocers. Our partnerships provide us great purchasing power stretching donor dollars to feed more people.
- We are 100% volunteer based. There are no paid positions.
- Other than food, our expenses include rent, utilities and basic administrative costs – no salaries.

We are privately funded and rely 100% on the generosity of our volunteers and donations from individuals, businesses, and religious and/or local community organizations.
